Dear Friends in Christ,

The Parish of St. Patrick is happy to announce that a new Parish Administrator has been hired to replace long-time employee, Janet Enriquez, who will retire in April. Ms. Susannah Ruth of Thousand Oaks will step into this important role mid-March when she will begin training.
